## YOUR BOAT:

Clean your boat while on dry land, away from the lake. If your boat has been in other lakes, it could be carrying small organisms or invasive plants. Make sure your boat is running properly. If you notice an oil slick behind your engine, get the leak repaired. Make sure to dispose of drained lubricating oils at a recycling facility or bring the oil to your local dealer for disposal.

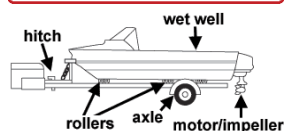

## Check List for Spring

**YOUR HOME: Pump your septic tank.** Check your septic system's leach field for any breakouts and consider having the tank pumped if it has not been pumped in the last 3 years. A properly functioning septic system prevents harmful pollutants from getting into the lake.

**Check the shoreline** and other areas of the property for soil erosion. Stabilize these areas with vegetation or rock riprap.

**Do not** rake up the duff layer of leaves and pine needles that build up under the trees. These leaves act like a sponge and filter, and help prevent pollutants from getting into the lake. As a cottage owner it is one of the best things you can do to protect lake water quality.
