Eligible Maine residents can receive a partial refund of property taxes and/or rent paid on their primary residence. I'm sure you have received forms in the mail, but if you've cast them aside you should take a moment to fill out the form, you might just qualify. It's incredibly easy and quick. All you need is a figure off of your Maine State Tax return and the amount of property taxes that you paid. You may only receive a small amount, but that's better than no amount.
