WLA Meeting, April 15th

Please join us for the upcoming meeting of the Lake Association scheduled for Friday, April 15th, at the Fox Glen Snowmobile Clubhouse.

This promises to be a good meeting with several guest speakers. The Association will provide coffee and dessert during a brief social time at 6:00 before the meeting and the business meeting will start at 6:30.



Josh Platt from Kennebec County Soil and Water Conservation District will be at the meeting to discuss the possibilities of a follow-on 319 grant proposal to our last successful grant. This proposal will focus on buffer plantings as a way to reduce the phosphorous loading on the lake.

Barbara Welsh from the Maine DEP will be speaking on Lakefront buffers: How to keep your beautiful 180 degree view. She will discuss how buffers work, storm water runoff and the sources that contaminate that runoff.

Nate Gray from the Maine Department of Marine Resources will update us on this year's Alewife restocking and fish way topics.

Please note that we will have a change in the format at this meeting! We will not have the usual potluck supper on the 15th. The Fox Glen snowmobile club is located on Buck & Doe Trail: from Route 3 go 0.8 miles on Weeks Mills Road to Buck & Doe Trail, which is on the left. The club is the first building on the left on Buck & Doe Trail.

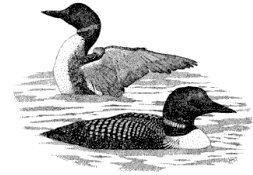
If you would like to help out with the meeting we can use some volunteers a little before 6:00 with setting up tables and chairs.
